Dear Sir:-

Referring to the matter of the planting of Madera Park, which it was decided when we last talked the matter over to postpone until about the middle of next month, beg to advise that during the last week of our balmy weather, many of the varieties of plants which are to be planted in your park are showing growth, and it would be advisable for the planting to be done not later than March 15th, otherwise in transplanting there is great danger of many of the plants after they are set out drooping and being set back in their growth for several months.

In view of the above we would recommend that the plants be forwarded to you as soon as possible.

The matter of the laying of the water pipe need not interfere to any great extent with the planting, as the plants which are planted along the lines of the water pipe can be heeled in and set out in their permanent places after the pipe is laid without any danger whatsoever to the plants.

It would be advisable that our man who is to lay these grounds out and do the planting be on the ground on the first of March, so as to have all the lines staked out and
